Membership Application/Renewal for 2008

Important note:

Membership for 2008 will run from 1st January 2008 to 30th September 2008. As a result, the membership fees have been amended to reflect this change for the coming year only. Thereafter, from 1st October 2008 onwards, membership will run from 1st October until 30th September of the following year. Please read the article in the December 2007 Chainletter for an explanation of the reasons for the change.

Introduction

Chelmsford & District Auto Club aims to cater for people interested in all aspects of motorcycling but primarily in Motocross/Scrambles and Trials either as competitors, organisers or spectators. During the summer season the club endeavours to organise two Motocross/Scrambles events whilst currently five trials are scheduled for 2008. From time to time the club may consider other types of events, such as Enduros and Grass Tracks and the Committee welcomes suggestions in this respect.

A newsletter is sent to all members on an occasional basis to inform them of happenings within the club. An optional Eastern Centre Gazette containing information of forthcoming events and entry forms can also be sent if required but at extra cost.

Membership Structure and Fees

1 Full Membership

Full Membership is available to all adult persons whether they compete in off-road events or not. The Annual Membership fee is £12.00 which includes a copy of the club newsletter (when produced), all privileges offered by the Club but **NOT** affiliation to the ACU or the Eastern Centre Gazette.

2 Associate Membership

Associate Membership is available to all adult persons who do **NOT** compete in off-road events. The Annual Membership fee is £10.00 which includes a copy of the Club Newsletter (when produced), all privileges offered by the Club but **NOT** affiliation to the ACU.

3 Lady Members

Lady Membership is available to all ladies who do **NOT** compete in off-road events. The Annual Membership fee is £2.00 as a non-competitor. Any lady member wishing to compete in any off-road discipline must be a full member.

4 Junior Members

Junior Membership is available to all persons who, when or if in competition, would come under the jurisdiction of the ACU rules for youths, i.e. those persons of age 16 or under.

The Annual Membership fee is £7.00.

5 Short Term Members

Short Term Membership is available to all persons who are members of another ACU affiliated club and wish to compete in Chelmsford & District Auto Club events, this being restricted to one such membership per calendar year.

The Membership Fee is £4.00 and allows members to compete in events promoted by Chelmsford & District Auto Club for a period of six (6) days from membership having been effected.

Short Term Membership is only available to any one person once per year.

Anyone joining as a Short Term Member who subsequently joins as a Full Member during the same membership year will become eligible to have the membership fee in force at that time reduced by £4.00.

6 Eastern Centre Gazette

Any Member may elect to receive a copy of the Eastern Centre Gazette each month at an additional fee (for 2008 this amounts to £5.40 for the Gazette plus £2.10 towards postage costs).

7 Period of Membership

Membership of Chelmsford & District Auto Club will be for a maximum period of 9 calendar months commencing on 1st January (or in the case of new members from the time of membership approval) and ending on 30th September of the same year. The Committee reserves the right to allow a reduced membership fee for new members whose approval commences after 1st June for the year in question.

8 Refusal of Membership

The Committee of the Chelmsford & District Auto Club reserve the right to refuse membership to any person and to terminate the membership of any person who, in the opinion of the Committee, causes the Club and/or off-road motorcycle sport to be brought into disrepute.
